Option 2 – Saturday 10 September

- One Small Cottage Tea Rooms for Morning Tea
- Northern Valleys Locavore Store to collect your Picnic-to-Go
- Begin your scenic drive to Wannamal, referring to the Chittering Wildflower Trail brochure (downloaded or collected from the Chittering Visitors Centre).
- Arriving in Wannamal for the Chittering Landcare Wildflower Show
- Enderslea Farm - Wattle Talk & Farm Tour (1pm) & where you can enjoy your picnic!
